## **Contact Information**

The Caravan and Motorhome Club's website has been designed with accessibility in mind, and includes keyboard navigation and Browsealoud texthelp. The Website complies with the W3C level A guidelines.

## **Arrival and Car Parking Facilities**

This site is approached by a tarmac surfaced gently sloped drive that passes through a gate to the site. There is no barrier. Visitor parking is on an open and level grassed area 25m from reception, but with no marked spaces. Late arrivals spaces are also on the same grassed area, providing 2 grass pitches, non ehu which are around 40m from reception.

## **Reception**

From the level tarmac road surface, there is a dropped kerb to a loose chippings surfaced drive, and then a level concrete paved path to a 180mm step to the reception. The outward-opening door has 700mm clear opening width, with a glazed vision panel from 900mm height, and clearly identified lever handle at 950mm height. The call bell for attention is on the door frame at 1300mm height. As a result this building is not accessible to a wheelchair user at present. Internally, there is space for a turning circle of 1500mm, and the counter is at 950mm height, with a lower section of 800mm width and at 750mm height at the fold-down flap. There is no hearing induction loop system to assist hearing aid users.

## **Pitches**

There are 8 identified accessible pitches that are within reasonable distance of the water service point and reception. They are all of level, grassed surface, with no roll-out mats. There are 2 groups of 4 accessible pitches. One group is located on the road along from reception, at around 75m to 85m from reception, and 35m to 45m from the water service point along level tarmac roads. The second group is accessed via a tarmac road over the bridge, which has a gradient of 1:15, but otherwise the route is level to both reception at around 55m to 65m distance, and the nearest water service point, along a road of loose stone chippings, at around 50 to 60m distance.

## **Circulation around the Site**

This is generally a level site, with a 3m wide level tarmac surface in front of the reception building and passing into the site. An area across the bridge opposite reception that has 3m wide loose stone chippings surfaced roads. The even tarmac surfaced main site roads are for shared vehicular and pedestrian use. There are loose stone chippings roads 3m wide leading off the main roads to groups of pitches with grass surfaces.

## **Toilet Blocks**

The site does not have a toilet block.

## Other Facilities

There is no **dishwashing room** or **laundry**.

There is a small timber hut **information room**, which is currently inaccessible to a wheelchair user because of the 160mm step and 130mm kerb leading to it, as well as the door of only 740mm clear opening width, and restricted internal space.

The **public telephone** booth entrance is attached to the reception building, approached by the same path, and with a step of 90mm into it. Internal space is limited to 950mm by 750mm, with an outward opening door which has a clear opening width of 700mm, with glazed vision panel from 1400mm height, and a visually contrasted lever handle at 1000mm height. The telephone has hearing enhancement, at a coin slot height of 1400mm.
