



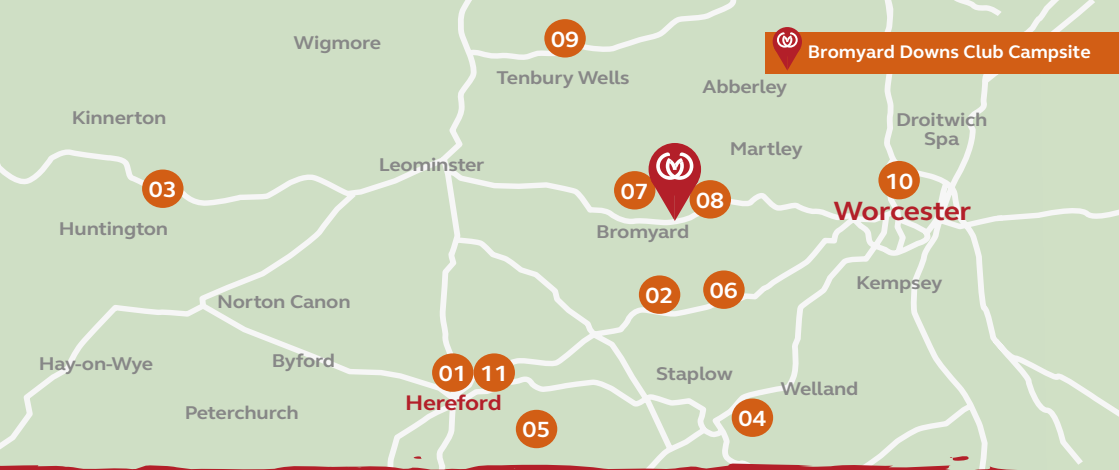

Over 50 acres of gardens with over 4000 rare shrubs and trees, one of the finest collections in Britain.
- 4 Eastnor Castle**  
Early 19th Century castle surrounded by a 5000 acre estate. Dogs are welcome in the grounds.

## Walk

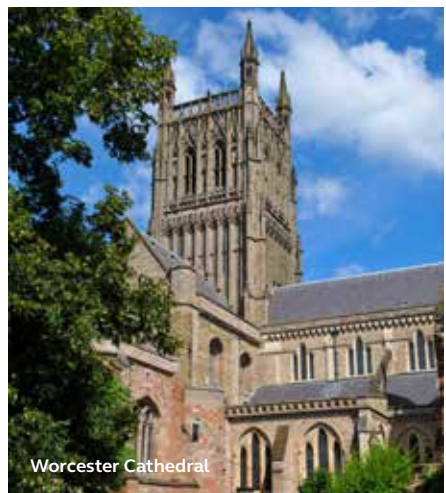
- 7 Bromyard Downs to Bringsty Common**

## Visitor's top tips

**||** Bromyard Downs is open access common land, with wooded glades and ponds, excellent for walking with stunning views and a dog friendly local pub within walking distance.

Bringsty common, within 1.5 miles of the site, is excellent for walking with a 16th century pub and garden.

Bromyard is a town of festivals, with local shops, pubs and restaurants, a 5 min drive or 40 min walk.

Worcester and Hereford good to visit and not far away, as is Ludlow, which is a delight if you are a foodie!

The Live and Let Live pub on Bringsty Common serves good food, excellent hosts and a lovely garden. It is also dog friendly.

You can join the Worcester to Birmingham canal at Worcester. This is a lovely cycle ride along the canal, you can go as far as you like. **||**

## Close by

### Supermarkets

Co-op in Bromyard, 2 miles. Morrisons, Sainsbury's, Tesco and Waitrose are within a 12 mile radius.

### Public transport

There are buses to Bromyard, Hereford and Worcester from the site entrance. Please note they do not allow dogs on board.

### Petrol station

Gulf, 1.6 miles or Top Garage in Bromyard is 2.4 miles from site.

### Swimming Pool

Pools are in Leominster, Ledbury, Worcester, Malvern and Tenbury Wells.
