At a Glance

3 Level Access

 There is level access to most of the facilities on site. The dog walk is only accessible over grass

Arrival and Reception

Approach Route

- The reception building is on the left hand side when you enter the site
- There is no entry barrier to the site
- The ground is level in this area with hard surfaced paths linking facilities.

Parking

- A new arrival bay is set within a few metres of the Reception building.
- There are no visitor parking spaces on site, but visitors can park on the tarmac near reception
- There are no late night arrival bays

Entrance into Reception

- The entrance door is level to the ground outside, with no pavement around the reception
- The Entrance door is 750mm wide over a 50mm threshold
- The entrance door is not power assisted, and opens inwards
- A call bell is available to summon assistance at 1400mm high





Reception

- There is approximately 1400mm x 3000mm turning space, clear of the desk and furniture
- The reception desk is set 850mm above the floor, there is no dropped section to the desk
- The reception does sell a variety of groceries and ice creams
- The desk is not fitted with a hearing loop



Getting around the Site

- The site is generally sloping throughout, some routes are fairly steep and may be difficult for those with mobility issues
- Pedestrians share vehicles routes which are well maintained tarmac, but do incorporate speed bumps

Pitches

- There are 53 pitches on site, 39 of which are hardstanding
- Roll out mats are not provided
- There are no designated accessible pitches, however pitches are allocated according to your needs or preference, so please contact us in advance to discuss your requirements.
- There are 4 hardstanding pitches within 40 meters of the Accessible Toilet and Reception

Toilets and Changing Facilities

Accessible Toilets and Bathing Facilities – Reception Block

- A combined Accessible Toilet and Shower cubicle is located in the reception building which is set at the end of the reception block
- There is level approach to the Toilet and Shower room, however it is down a path that is 1000mm wide
- The door is 750mm wide, over a flush threshold and opens inwards
- The cubicle door is secured by RADAR key. A key can be borrowed from Reception
- The cubicle is an L shape, the largest area is 2400mm x 1660mm
- The WC pan is right hand transfer.
- The shower seat is right hand transfer
- The toilet seat is 480mm, and the shower seat is 500mm above the floor level
- The clear space to the side of the toilet is 1700mm wide
- The cubicle is fitted with a pull cord alarm, which is tested frequently
- The shower seat and WC Pan are fitted with grab rails to assist transfer
- Shower controls are 1000mm high
- The shower head is fitted on a sliding rail, which is a minimum of 1200mm above floor level
- The basin taps and shower controls are fitted with levers



Baby and Toddler Room - Reception Block

- There is a baby and toddler room in the reception block which is accessed via a level path
- The door is 650mm wide and opens inwards with a 50mm step in
- A key can be borrowed from the reception

- There is 1000mm x 1300mm clear space for maneuvering
- There is a lower WC
- There is a half sized bathtub with a shower above
- There is a drop down baby change table at 850mm high



Standard Toilets and Washrooms

- There is one toilet and shower block in the middle of the site
- There is no parking available next to the toilet block
- Entrance doors are accessed by a ramped path or by steps, with a single handrail to each
- The female area has 4 WC cubicles, 4 Privacy Washbasin cubicles and 3 Shower cubicles
- The male area has 2 urinals, including one lower urinal, 3 WC cubicles, 3 Privacy Washbasin cubicles and 3 Shower cubicles
- Taps in the toilet block incorporate lever controls



Other Facilities

Dishwashing – Toilet Block

- The dishwashing area is to the side of the toilet block, undercover but with no door to access
- There are 3 sinks at 900mm high
- There is 1500mm wide space behind the sinks for maneuvering
- Lever taps available



Laundry - Toilet Block

- The Laundry room is at the back of the toilet block, accessed by a level paved path
- The door is 750mm wide, over a level threshold and opens inwards
- The room is an L shape, with a 1500mm turning circle
- There is only 750mm space between the sink and the wall
- There is a front loading washing machine and a front loading tumble dryer with coin slots at 1050mm
- There is 1 sink at 900mm high with no knee space below
- Lever taps fitted



Information Room – Adjacent to Reception

- Access via slopes which lead to small level platforms
- Each side of the double doors are 700mm wide, and one is usually held open
- The room's dimensions are 1150 x 1850mm
- Information is displayed on a shelf at 1200mm high



Dog Walk

- There is a dog walk around the east of the site
- There is an 850mm wide gate to access
- The ground is grass and can be uneven in parts
- There is an exit gate to the dog walk path which is 1600mm wide





Play Area

- There is a play area, which is a large grass area to the east of the site
- There is a gravelled area to access the play area
- The play area is accessed through an 850mm wide gate



Service Points

- There are two Service Points around the site, please check the site map for details
- The service points are set on concrete settings with level access from the roads
- The paths around the Service Points can be as narrow as 700mm wide
- The water taps are at a maximum of 800mm high, with cross head taps
- Chemical Waste Points can be found here too



Motorhome Waste Point

• There is one Motorhome Waste Point on site, located close to the reception block
