### **Arrival and Reception**

#### **Approach Route**

- Access onto the site is via a tarmac driveway
- The reception building is on the right hand side when you enter the site
- The gate from the road is left open at all times but access into the site is controlled via a vehicle barrier controlled by card access.
- The ground is level in this area with hard surfaced paths linking facilities.

#### **Parking**

- A new arrival bay is set within a few metres of the Reception building.
- There is space for 2 cars to park temporarily adjacent to the reception
- There are no late arrival bays

### **Entrance into Reception**

- There is a 120mm step to access reception
- The Entrance door is 750mm wide over a 60mm threshold
- The entrance door is not power assisted, and opens inwards
- A call bell is available to summon assistance, this is 1250mm above ground level





#### Reception

- There is approximately 2200mm x 1450mm turning space, clear of the desk and furniture
- The reception desk is set 900mm above the floor with no dropped section
- The desk is not fitted with a hearing loop



## **Getting around the Site**

- The site slopes throughout, however the path to the service point opposite "Ram's Bottom" is very steep (1:3 gradient)
- Pedestrians share vehicles routes which are well maintained tarmac, but do incorporate speed bumps
- There is a pathway from the reception to the toilet block, however this can be uneven in places due to roots from trees

#### **Pitches**

- There are 50 pitches on site, 11 of which are hardstanding
- Roll out mats are not provided
- There are no designated accessible pitches, however pitches are allocated according to your needs or preference, so please contact us in advance to discuss your requirements.



## **Toilets and Changing Facilities**

Accessible Toilets and Bathing Facilities – Toilet Block

- A combined Accessible Toilet and Shower cubicle is located in the Toilet Block which is set near the entrance of the site
- The toilet block is accessed via a dropped kerb to the paved area around the toilet block
- The door is 900mm wide, over a level threshold and opens outwards
- The cubicle door is secured by a key. A key can be borrowed from Reception
- The cubicle's overall dimensions are 2200mm x 1800mm
- The WC pan is left hand transfer.
- The shower seat is left hand transfer
- The toilet seat is 480mm, and the shower seat is 500mm above the floor level
- The clear space to the side of the toilet is 850mm wide
- The cubicle is fitted with a pull cord alarm, which is tested frequently
- The shower seat and WC Pan are fitted with grab rails to assist transfer
- Shower controls are 1000mm high
- The shower head is fitted on a sliding rail, which is a minimum of 1350mm above floor level
- The basin taps and shower controls are fitted with levers







#### **Standard Toilets and Washrooms**

- There is one toilet and shower block, which is set near the entrance of the site
- Parking for one vehicle is available next to Toilet Block
- Entrance doors are accessed by a paved area, which is accessed via a dropped kerb
- The female facilities contain 3 WC cubicles, 3 Shower cubicles and 3 Privacy Washbasin cubicles
- The male facilities contain 3 WC cubicles, 2 Urinals including 1 lower Urinal, 3
   Shower cubicles and 3 Privacy Washbasin cubicles
- There are modified cubicles in each area for each type of cubicle, with grab rails to assist transfer and mobility
- Taps in each block incorporate lever controls





#### **Other Facilities**

#### **Dishwashing – Toilet Block**

- The dishwashing area is an open area to the side of the toilet block
- There is 2200mm x 1050mm clear space in front of the sinks
- There are 2 sinks at 850mm high with 650mm knee space below
- Twist turn taps available



### **Laundry – Toilet Block**

- Level access via paved area
- The door is 900mm wide over a level threshold and opens outwards
- There is 2650mm x 1900mm manoeuvring space
- There is 1 front loading Washing Machine and 1 front loading Tumble Dryer
- There are 2 sinks at 850mm high with 670mm knee space below
- Lever taps fitted







#### Information Room - Adjacent to Reception

- There is an information room in an external wooden hut behind the reception building
- The door is 780mm wide over a 250mm step and opens outwards
- The room's dimensions are 1100mm x 1700mm
- Information is displayed on a shelf at 900mm high



#### **Service Points**

- There are Service Points at intervals around the site, please check the site map for details
- All of the service points are on raised concrete settings, with level access from adjacent roadways
- The paths around the Service Points can be as narrow as 800mm wide
- The water taps are at a maximum of 1000mm high, with cross head taps
- Chemical Waste Points can be found here too, with taps at a maximum of 1200mm high





#### **Motorhome Waste Point**

- There is one Motorhome Waste Point on site, located to the East of the site
- The taps are 1150mm high, mounted on a 110mm kerb
